

Required CCP Hours

Continuing Competence Program

Full members

Those members having held a full practice permit for an entire cycle of the Continuing Competence Program (CCP) are required to complete a minimum of 24 hours of learning.

Those members registered in two or more specialties are required to complete one Continuing Competence Program. Within this program, it is the member's discretion as to the subject matter on which the reflective learning is accomplished.

Full members for less than 12 months

Those members who have not held a full practice permit for an entire CCP cycle are required to complete learning for those months, or part thereof, in which they held a full permit during the CCP cycle. For a breakdown of required hours, please see the chart below.

Members with temporary practice permits

Members practicing with a temporary practice permit (TPP) are not required to participate in the CCP for the months in which they hold a TPP. However, it is highly encouraged that these members partake in reflective learning during this time.

Associate members

Associate membership is a non-regulated category and as such these technologists are not required to participate in the CCP for the months in which they hold associate membership.
